Daytona Beach rolled out the red carpet and did an excellent job welcoming





As most are aware, 16 year old Sean English was involved in a horrific accident on Sunday, April 2nd, on his way to church. Sean and his family approached an overturned vehicle on I-96, stopping to help; Sean was hit by another vehicle and suffered serious

injuries ultimately causing the amputation of his right leg below the knee. I have the fortune of working with Sean's Dad, also named Sean. As a friend I reached out offering whatever I could do to ease their pain. As a Shriner, I offered Shriners Hospitals for Children—Chicago. On Saturday, April 22nd Sean and the family agreed to what Shriners Hospitals for Children had to offer, on June 23rd it became real as Sean and family made their first trip Shriners Hospitals for Children—Chicago.

Now for the Everything Happens for Reason. As mentioned above, the Detroit Shriners Magazine will be getting to your homes later than normal this month as the printing press used broke down and parts were not readily available to make the repairs. Today, Wednesday, July 16, 2017, as Sean was at physical therapy he told his therapist that he wanted to walk. Determined, Sean was fitted with an "extra" leg that was not fitted for him. Today, Sean took 8 steps unaided—less than 4 month since his accident. So, the printing press went down for a reason, the unavailability of parts was for a reason, the delay in delivering the Detroit Shriners Magazine was for a reason.
