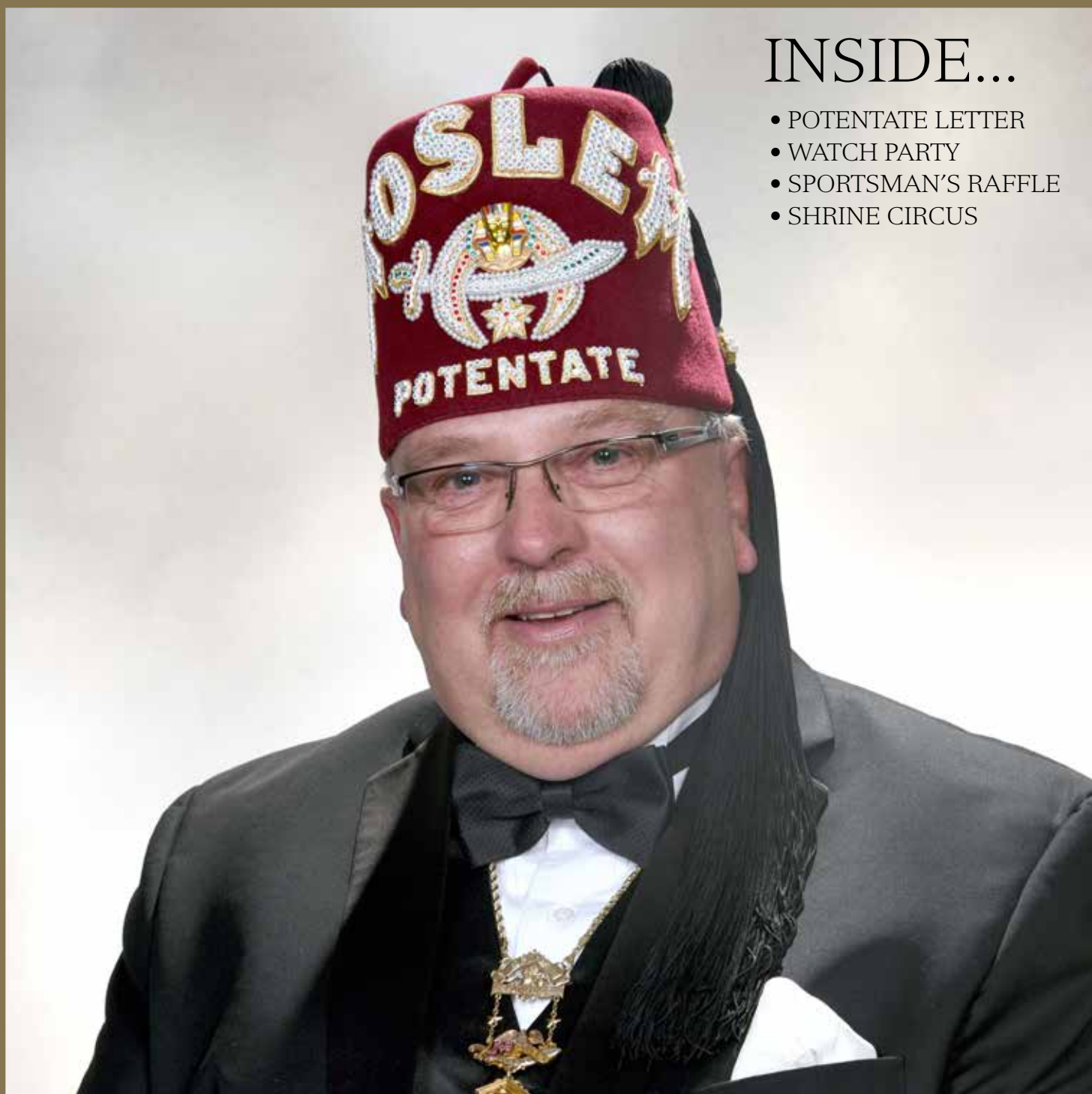

MESSAGE FROM OUR POTENTATE

Nobles All - Greetings

I am truly humbled after being installed as the 138th Potentate to lead Moslem Shrine Temple. To quote a verse of the Bible, Luke 12:48 - "From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked".

While our road has been hard, while our journey has been long, we have picked ourselves up, we have fought our way back, and we know in our hearts that for Moslem Shriners, the best is yet to come. It was a little more than 1 year ago that my Father-In-Law could not physically attend the Installation of Officers so we did Face-time so he could view the ceremony. SHRINERS WINTER SPORTSMANS RAFFLE

The 4rd Annual Winter Sportsman's Raffle is right around the corner. The event will be held on Saturday, February 3rd at the Suburban Collection Showplace from 11:00 until 5:00. Boy, how time flies! It seems like we just finished our first Winter Raffle and here we are on our fourth....

We will occupy the same space as last year, the 140,000 sq. ft. on the East end of the hall. The look will be the same for the most part. In 2017 we had nearly 7,000 people so, I'm going to anticipate a modest increase hoping for 7,500 people in attendance.

With the success of past events and a slightly larger crowd anticipated, I see a need for additional volunteer help at the event. The 2017 Winter Raffle 50/50 paid out \$21,175 to the winner and I expect that to grow this year. Randy's 52-card gun raffle sold 94 decks (Randy's current personal record) and we are aiming to break the coveted 100 deck mark this year! We gave away over 235 firearms all day and had 2 dozen side raffles that also did well. The more people that attend, the better off the Units and Clubs also do.

Starting this year, if a winner selects the gift card option in lieu of taking a firearm, they may use their gift card at either Bass Pro Shops or Cabela's! This is a nice option for those winners that don't want or need another firearm. Both stores have a huge assortment of men's and women's clothing as well as fishing, camping and hunting gear.

We are marketing the usual way and the Suburban Collection Showplace is helping big time. SCS has us on their internal webpage that is emailed to their entire customer base, our posters are displayed in 20 glass cases in lobbies, bathrooms, etc. across the complex. We have a 30' banner on the building that can be seen from I-96 and we are displayed on the electronic billboards that can be seen on I-96 and Grand River. SCS also shares our event on their Facebook page and postcard mailing to all their contact lists. Whew, I'm tired just trying to list all they do for us!

This is our largest single-day fundraiser so, let's all give a final push this month to fill the room and show that the Shriners know how to throw a party. It's important to remember 1. The funds we generate are important to our Temple and 2. This event is a great membership recruitment tool for both our Masonic and Shrine fraternities. Anyone over the age of 16 can enter and volunteer. Please put this event on your calendar. Volunteers must through the parking gate by 9:30. Call the office with questions at 248-569-2900 ext. 3. what are... FINANCIAL STATEMENTS?

Each of the financial statements required by General Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) focuses on a different aspect of the company's financial position or financial activity. All four statements should be analyzed in order to get a complete picture of a company.

Balance sheets show the financial position of the company at specific points in time. The income statement shows the change in equity that result from the operation of the business during the year. The statement of owner's equity shows the change in equity from owner contributions plus profits earned less owner withdrawals during the year. The cash flow statement shows the change in Cash in relation to everything else that changed during the year.
