Mike, who has now reached the revered age of seventy-one, is one of our best known and best liked Moslem Shriners. He has been very active at several levels in our fraternity, including his successful hitch as our Illustrious Potentate in 2012. He and his lovely wife Lora, who most of us know as a charming and very personable lady, have contributed a great deal to the well-being of our Temple, both for the men's and lady's organizations and activities.

Ill. Sir Mike! He went to school at Trombly Trade and then on to Notre Dame High, and in 1962, at age seventeen, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He had his Navy basic training at Great Lakes, in Illinois. He was trained in Aviation Ordinance and assigned to the air craft carrier Independence.

After his Navy hitch, he got an electrical apprenticeship at Harlen Electric with that late great Shriner, Helmut Krippendorf. After about eight years working there, he moved to Detroit Edison as a journeyman outside lineman. Mike joined the Fraser Blue Lodge and the Shrine in 1976.

In his many and varied Shrine activities, besides being our 2012 Potentate, at one time or another, he was General Chairman, Chief of Staff, Chief Aide, Director of the Jesters in 2005 and President of the J.O.M. in 2009 and is now an Imperial Colorado Rep., in addition to being our current Moslem Convention/ Housing Chairman. He is also a long-time member of the Taylor Shrine Club, was a piper in the Highlanders and is now a member of our rowdy Americans Unit, frequently riding on



top of their stagecoach in our parades and happily reliving some of the old party days of his teens. On the down side, their stage coach does not win a lot of drag-races.

Mike says "It is a great privilege to be named "Honoree" of the Moslem Shrine Spring Class of 2017. The Shrine has been a part of my life for over forty years. The friends I have made through those years have become family to me. I want to humbly and sincerely thank Illustrious Potentate Art Brdak for this incredible honor."
