

Our CPA firm is assisting in working on our chart of accounts and general ledger to make it more efficient and provide the Divan with monthly reports that are so necessary for operating our business. I have sent out surveys to all our Unit Directors and to our Divan to measure their opinion on our direction, our future, and issues

that concern them. It is always good to get a different perception. I hope to have surveys completed by our Nobility at our business meeting on November 7. They should only take a few minutes and will help me gauge the opinion of our Nobility.

Our goal for this quarter is to continue working on improving our income streams for the future, improve how we operate our business and how account for our income and expense. Our Divan only has so much discretionary spending and if we cut all of it, it would have less than a 5% impact on our overall budget. We have cut most unnecessary expenses about as far as they can be cut. This indicates that our path to a balanced budget is to increase our revenue streams, year over year, through events like the Michigan State Fair, Silver Gardens, the Sportsman Raffles and by the addition of new events producing significant income for our Temple. We need to leverage our circus and continue to increase profits from this source. Our Divan will continue to explore innovative income solutions through discussions with other Temples, the Imperial and outside sources. It is imperative that we end up with a balanced budget each and every year and get to a point where we can dedicate a portion of our budget to a reserve for the Temple.



This is our goal and we will keep working towards it with diligence and creativity.
