#### **MESSAGE FROM OUR POTENTATE**

## MEMBERSHIP

I wanted to get the message out as early as possible that there will be some changes in regards to Membership for 2019. As you know, membership has steadily declined to the point that we are currently at 1,922 and dropping (this is as of 12/30/2018). In order to reverse this downward trend, we will be adopting the membership goals and activities of several other Shrine Temples that have had ceremonial class sizes in the hundreds. John Arkles – Membership Chairman – and his team will be sending out the action plan on how we will meet our goals along with regular communications updating the Nobility on our status.

For 2019, we will be implementing the following:

- The fee to become a member of Moslem Shrine will be \$100.00. This will include dues and their fez.
- It is expected that ALL members of Moslem actively promote Shrine membership within their Blue Lodges and with their friends and family. Keep in mind that this activity is not limited to the Nobles, our Ladies can also promote membership as well and are encouraged to do so.
- Our Membership team, Past Masters, Unit Directors, Club Presidents and Ambassadors will be tasked with reaching out to all the Blue Lodges in our territory outlining this promotion. They will also be calling upon those Nobles that are active in their Blue Lodges as well for assistance.
- If a Blue Lodge desires, an individual from the Membership Team, Ambassador or Divan will meet with those Lodge members and discuss the Shrine and the Shriners Hospitals for Children.
- It is vital that the Blue Lodges understand that we are not attempting to "steal" their members. All Shriners are encouraged to attend their Blue Lodge functions.
- The spring ceremonial has been cancelled. We will have a fall ceremonial which will be held on November 9th with a minimum goal of 150 new members being brought in.
- We will be offering short forms on a monthly basis for those that want to join, but do not want to wait until November to become a Noble. They will, however, be required to attend the fall Ceremonial.

In addition to these activities, we are also enacting a Potentate's Unit where all new members will be placed. This is designed to ensure that the newly created Nobles have an opportunity to meet and interact with a wide range of Nobles, Ladies, Units, and Clubs and to keep them active and engaged.

In order to leave the Potentate's Unit and join another – Highlanders, Lancers, etc. – they will be required to complete the following steps:

- Participate in 3 parades they can march with the Divan or with any other Unit that they so choose.
- Participate in 3 Shrine events work the Circus, State Fair, Sportsman's Raffle, Meat Raffle, etc.
- Attend 3 Unit meetings this is to be 3 different Units Clowns, Americans, etc. and their presence will have to be signed off by the Unit Director of each of these Units.
- Attend 2 stated business meetings

Once the Membership team confirms that these actions have taken place, the Noble can then officially transfer to the Unit of their choice or they may choose not to join a Unit at all.

Lastly, Each newly created Noble and their Lady will be given a purple name tag. At any Shrine function, if there is a Noble or Lady present wearing one of these name tags it will be expected that all current




